1. Appointment of a Bond Architect

To appoint Burton, Behrendt & Smith (BBS) as the Bond Architect for the 2015-2016 school year at 5.5% of the total construction cost.

2. Consulting Services/SEQRA

To authorize the agreement between the Valley Stream UFSD Board of Education and J. C. Broderick & Associates, Inc. for preparation of SEQRA review for possible Bond Referendum at an approximate cost of \$2,400 as per Nassau BOCES RFP; and to authorize the Board President to sign said agreement.

5. Certifying Lead Evaluators to Conduct Teacher and Principal Evaluations under Education Law 3012-c

BE IT RESOLVED that, in accordance with the provisions of New York State Education Law 3012-c and subpart 30-2 of the Regulations of the Commissioner of Education, the Board of Education of the Valley Stream Union Free School District Thirteen ("District") hereby certifies Dr. Alan Groveman as a qualified Lead Evaluator.

6. Employment of a Special Education Teacher

To employ Antonella Sciscioli as a Special Education Teacher (Tenure Area: Students with Disabilities Grades Birth - 6), assigned to Willow Road School on Step 1MA (\$68,231), on four years probation commencing on September 1, 2015 and expiring on August 30, 2019. In order to be granted tenure, the teacher must have received composite or overall APPR ratings pursuant to Education Law §3012-c and/or 3012-d of either "effective" or "highly effective" in at least three ("3") of the four ("4") preceding years, and, if the classroom teacher receives an "ineffective" composite or overall APPR rating in the final year of the probationary period, he or she shall not be eligible for tenure at that time.
