

## BOARD COMMITTEES

The Board may, at any time, by resolution, establish any committee and define the scope of its responsibility, which action require the President to appoint such a committee. The President shall appoint Board members as necessary to such standing or special committees for expediting business, duties, and responsibilities of the Board.

Each Board member shall be appointed to a standing committee. Board members shall accept committee appointments except for compelling reasons. Committees shall report to the Board and make recommendations for Board action, but shall have no other authority.

All committees shall function until discharged by the Board or until the next reorganizational meeting.

### A. Committee of the Whole

The Board shall meet as a Committee of the Whole at the request of any member of the Board or the Superintendent. The Vice-President will serve as chair of this committee. Subsequent meetings on the same subject shall require the approval of the majority of the Board.

### B. Standing Committees

- (1) Education
- (2) Business Administration
- (3) Policy Committee
- (4) Facilities Committee

### C. Special Committees

The Board President may appoint special (ad hoc) committees from the Board's membership for study, negotiations, and fact finding as the Board deems necessary.

### D. Advisory Committees

The Board may appoint committees to investigate and make recommendations to the Board on specific issues designated by the Board. Such committees may include members of the community and district staff. One Board member may be designated by the President as Board representative to each advisory committee established by the Board.
