

SCHOOL BOARD LEGAL STATUS

The Board of Education is composed of seven members elected by district residents. Each member of the Board serves for three years. The terms of office of Board members shall not all expire in the same year. Board members are elected to oversee and direct the functioning of the school district.

The legal status of the Board is that of a corporate body established pursuant to the laws of New York State. Any liability of the district is a liability of the Board of Education as a corporation and not that of the members of the Board as individuals.
