

SCHOOL BOARD POWERS AND DUTIES EXHIBIT

The functions of the Board of Education include:

1. Lend cooperative efforts to establish district goals and meet educational objectives.
2. Formulate district policies and evaluate administrative rules and regulations.
3. Evaluate and improve the effectiveness of Board policies.
4. Review, discuss and evaluate the progress of the school system.
5. Discuss and communicate needs of school to community and needs of community to school.
6. Encourage community participation *in broad based planning* and budget preparation.
7. Plan, review and adopt proposed school budget.
8. Approve all personnel hiring, terminations and relevant changes, upon recommendations of the Superintendent.
9. Negotiate and approve salaries, agreements and contracts for all personnel.
10. Continually maintain the educational objectives through Board action.
