

BOARD-SUPERINTENDENT RELATIONSHIP

The Board will determine the policies governing all activities of the district's schools in order to guide the administrative decision-making process. In creating these policies it may seek the advice and assistance of faculty, staff employee organizations and community, through the Superintendent of Schools.

The Superintendent will assist the Board in:

1. understanding the functions of each staff member as well as the relationships between and among them;
2. establishing clear lines of communication with staff members and the community;
3. appointing special committees; and
4. furnishing channels so that recommendations of individuals and groups can be heard and reviewed by the appropriate administrator, and when necessary, by the Board.
