

## **BOND REFERENDUM PHASE II WORK SCOPE DETAILED PHASE II WORK TO BEGIN SUMMER 2017**

Projects included in the district's Bond Referendum approved by the community in December 2015 are advancing on schedule and on-budget. Phase I work is now complete, which consisted of roof replacement and chimney reconstruction at all four of the district's school buildings. Concrete repair was also done at entranceways to the Howell Road and James A. Dever elementary schools.



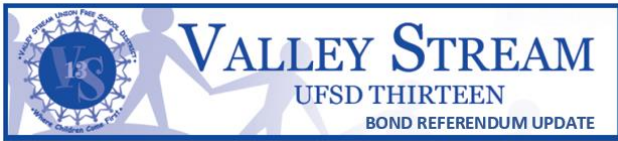
Planning for Phase II work is in process, with work to begin this summer (summer, 2017).

Phase II projects will be focusing on security measures and system replacements. Unless otherwise noted, Phase II work summarized below will take place at all four school buildings in the district.

### **SECURITY AND SAFETY**

- Replacement of corridor doors and hardware
- Upgrading of motion detection systems
- Additional CCTV security cameras and monitoring systems
- Card access systems at four (4) doors (in each building)
- Replacement of P.A. systems

There is also the possibility of installation of magnetic hold-opens at cafeterias, auditoriums and gymnasiums



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**ARCHITECTRAL**

- Wheelchair lift at Dever
- Gymnasium painting and floor refinishing
- Relocation of Wheeler playground / playground resurfacing

**PLUMBING**

- Removal of hot water storage tanks
- Replacement of drinking fountains
- Replacement of exterior hose bibs
- Replacement of existing water heaters at two school buildings
- Installation of an eyewash station at the Wheeler nurse's office

**ENERGY PERFORMANCE CONTRACT PROJECTS**

- LED lighting upgrades
- Replacement of air handling units
- Replacement of pumps and pump motors
- Installation of pipe installation
- Building management system upgrades
- Installation of solar panels
