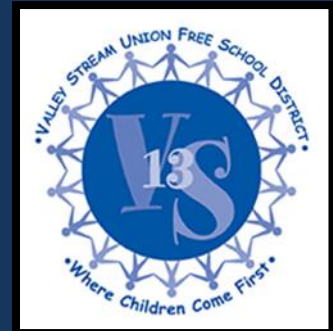

- Targeted Training for District/Building Safety Teams
- Regular Practice of Safety Drills



Emergency Drills



- Effective date July 1, 2016 (Bill S6829 passed with budget amends Education Law 807.1, 1-a)

Old Law	Updated Law
12 evacuation drills	8 evacuation drills, 4 lockdown drills
8 drills prior to December 1	8 drills prior to December 31
At least 1/3 of drills used fire escapes	4 of the evacuation drills will be through fire escapes or secondary means of egress
1 drill during lunch or the instruction on how to evacuate during lunch	1 drill during lunch or assembly unless instruction is provided on how to evacuate during lunch or assembly
2 additional drills during summer school, 1 within the first week of school	No change
After school programs, events, or performances – the person in charge must notify attendees at the beginning of the program, event, or performance on evacuation procedures	After school programs, events, or performances – the person in charge must notify attendees at the beginning of the program, event, or performance on emergency procedures

Strategic Safety Initiatives



- New PA System (Advance Sound) March 2018
 - Private two-way contact with every classroom
 - Increased communication capacity for each classroom
- Improved cell service for 2018-2019 school year

Smart Schools Bond Act Project - Phase I



- Interior and exterior cameras districtwide
 - Expandable system for future additions
- Key card access at high traffic entry points
 - VS13 ID badge required for entry
- Visitor management system
 - Licenses scanned against police databases

Smart Schools Bond Act

Multiple Integrations with NCPD



- Panic button at each school will trigger a lockdown
 - Recorded message plays to notify building occupants
 - 911 is autodialed
- District app for security monitoring allows administration to call for lockdown at the press of a button
- RAVE integration allows for immediate dispatch of officers and constant contact between 911 dispatch and those on the scene
