Dear Valley Stream UFSD Thirteen Community,

I'm writing to leverage our partnership to ensure the safety of our children. Many superintendents are grappling with March 14; a day some have deemed to be "National Student Walkout Day". In the interest of promoting safety, our district will not engage in taking our children outside on this day for the direct purpose of spending seventeen minutes during a preannounced exact timeframe.

Valley Stream UFSD Thirteen has planned a curriculum-based, developmentally appropriate initiative that will engage all of our schools focused on strengthening our community. Research focused on school violence demonstrates that the most critical way to keep our children safe is by ensuring that all children and families feel valued and respected as members of the school community. This is not meant to diminish the importance of implementing other safety and security measures which are under continued review in our district.

We have developed this day with critical input from our principals and teachers, and ideas from students. The purpose of this day is to engage our children in a meaningful action that is both appropriate for elementary students and meets the goal of respecting lives lost in acts of school violence. Our focus will be "I Can, We Can" (attachment).
