BE IT RESOLVED, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, and in accordance with the New York State Education Law, the Board of Education hereby appoints the following individual to a four-year probationary appointment to the position of Principal with tenure area of Principal, effective as noted unless terminated prior thereto in the manner prescribed by law. In order to be eligible for tenure, an individual receiving a probationary appointment as a Principal must receive annual composite or overall APPR ratings of Highly Effective or Effective in at least three of the four preceding years, and if the individual receives a rating of Ineffective in the final year of the probationary period, he or she will not be eligible for tenure at that time.
