Dear Valley Stream UFSD Thirteen Community,

Yesterday, Governor Andrew Cuomo announced that he would be issuing an executive order extending the deadline for school districts to receive school budget vote and board of education election absentee ballots by mail. All voting this year is by absentee ballot only. The new regulations permit absentee ballots to be hand delivered or dropped off at school districts through 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 9, or received by mail through Tuesday, June 16.

Qualified voters in the Valley Stream UFSD Thirteen can drop off their completed absentee ballots in the locked drop box that has been set up inside the main entrance of the James A. Dever School, 585 N. Corona Avenue, Valley Stream, today up to 2:00 p.m. and tomorrow, Tuesday, June 9, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. up to 5:00 p.m.

As provided for in the Governor's executive order, mailed ballots will be accepted by the district through Tuesday, June 16.
